

## WELCOME TO AKELALAND!



## Here is what your first day will look like: Upon Your Arrival (Must be after 12:00 pm)

First, travel to your campsite using as few vehicles as possible. Please drive very slowly. Registration will be done in the campsites. A site guide will arrive before your check-in time. They will be assigned to your unit to guide you to dining hall orientation and swim tests.

**CHECK-IN**: When it is time for your unit to check in, please have all Scouts and adults ready under the campsite's pavilion. In hand, each person should have all their medical forms. At this time, you will be asked to pay any balances owed or sign off that the payment is complete. You will hand in a Pioneer Camp Registration form for each Scout coming for the Pioneer Program.

\*IF YOUR PACK IS NOT READY AT YOUR ASSIGNED CHECK IN TIME, WE WILL RETURN AFTER WE CHECK IN OTHER UNITS.\*

**MEDICAL BOXES:** On your picnic table you will find a Medical Box. Inside, you will find copies of your schedule, a list of Requirements that the Scouts will complete this week, extra COVID and Pioneer forms, camp maps, and 2 CSPs (Council Shoulder Patch). All medications must be stored in a locked medical box that will be provided under your pavilion.

**MEDICAL CHECKS**: During your check-in time, our medical officer will go through your medical forms with you and a staff member may check your temperature. Once those are complete, you will receive a colored bracelet. These bracelets must be worn all week. **DINING HALL**: Next, your site guide will take you to the dining hall. You will have a brief introduction to the dining hall rules and procedures, and find your tables for the week.

**SWIM TESTS**: Last, your site guide will take you to the pool for swim tests. Please complete 2 buddy tags for each Scout and adult before arriving at the pool with the last name, first initial on the front and the campsite, pack and week number on the back. (An example Buddy Tag instruction sheet is in the medical box.) Each participant will be identified as a non-swimmer, beginner, or swimmer.

## \*After you are finished unpacking, please return vehicles to the parking lot. You are allowed <u>one vehicle per campsite</u>.
